This has reference to the proposal submitted by CMR Institute of Technology, Kandlakoya(V), Medchal Road, Hyderabad-501 401 Telangana, affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Hyderabad for extension of Autonomous Status.

The Commission in its meeting held on 25.06.2024 has approved the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Autonomous Colleges to extend the autonomous status to **CMR Institute of Technology, Kandlakoya(V), Medchal Road, Hyderabad-501 401 Telangana, affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Hyderabad** for a period of 10 years from the academic year **2023-2024 to 2032-2033** as per clause 8.2 of the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023.

The University, is therefore, requested to issue necessary notification within 30 days regarding the extension of autonomous status to the College as per UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023.

The autonomous college is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugc.gov.in. Non-compliance of the requirements and conditions prescribed in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -13 of the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023. The college should apply to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status at least three months before the completion of autonomy period.

Non-compliance of the above shall attract action as per Clause -13 of the UGC Regulations – 2023.
- (iii) The College/Institute is advised to take necessary steps for implementation of NEP 2020 and intimate the UGC.

In the reference (2) read above, the UGC has conferred Extension of Autonomous Status to CMR Institute of Technology, Kandlakoya (V), Medchal, Hyderabad, Telangana, affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad, Kukatpally, Hyderabad, Telangana, for a period of Ten (10) Years from the Academic Year 2023-24 to 2032-2033 as per Clause 8.2 of the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023 for Autonomous Colleges and subsequent regulations issued from time to time by the University.

Also, the UGC has stated that the autonomy granted colleges shall abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The college shall apply, in the prescribed format to the UGC, for extension of autonomous status atleast three months before the completion of autonomy period.
